



Cool In School

Overview: In this program, the children learn about appropriate behavior in school. Miss Pat, their teacher, reminds the children of the classroom rules and how these rules keep them safe in a learning environment. The children come to realize that their behavior has an impact on others.

Activity 1: Hector thinks he is cool in school. This activity asks the user to write or draw what Hector did in school that made him not cool. It asks why his classmates were annoyed with him and how Hector should have behaved.

Activity 2: Nellie knows about being cool in school. The questions asked in this activity can lead to a discussion about when it is appropriate to get out of your seat in class. It explores when and why you should raise your hand to get the teacher's attention.

Activity 3: Wendy knows when it is okay to talk in school. That makes her cool in school. This activity offers a series of multiple choice questions exploring situations when talking is permitted. It gives parents and teachers the chance to reinforce proper school behavior in a fun way.
