



Jay Wants to Win

Overview: Everyone has a favorite sport or activity. Jay really enjoys ping pong. There is a “for fun” tournament coming up at the Community Center and Jay wants to win...but at what price? Children using these activities can talk about whether it’s more important to be a good friend or to win a game.

Activity 1: Jay is the team captain and must choose who will be on his team. Does he choose his friend Bobby, who is not so good at ping pong or does he choose someone who will give his team the best chance at winning? Questions ask the children doing the activity what they would do under the circumstances.

Activity 2: In this activity, children get to describe and draw their favorite sport or activity as well as color the graphic.

Activity 3: This activity is about keeping score. Children are asked how many points did Jay’s team score and who was the winner. Children need to review the scores and add points to get the answers.
